Why talk about the End Times and Prophecy?

Bible in Three Statements

- Jesus Is Coming
 - Jesus Has Come
 - Jesus Is Coming Again
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- 30% of the Bible is Prophecy
 - 1 out of every 25 verses in the New Testament deals with the Second Coming
 - Jesus speaks of His Second Coming 21 times
 - 1800 statements about the Second Coming - 5 times more than the First Coming
 - God assures a blessing to those who study prophecy (Revelation 1:3)
 - Prophecy wasn't given to frighten us - it was written to encourage us

What is the Second Coming of Jesus?

Second Coming is the return of Jesus Christ to the earth to fulfill the remaining prophecies and fully establish the Kingdom of God on earth as it is in heaven.

- Living will be transformed
- Dead will be raised
- Creation will be healed and restored
- Believers will be rewarded
- Unbelievers/wicked will be judged and punished

"Men of Galilee," they said, "why are you standing here staring into heaven? Jesus has been taken from you into heaven, but someday he will return from heaven in the same way you saw him go!"

¹¹ Then I saw heaven opened, and a white horse was standing there. When will Jesus return?

“However, no one knows the day or hour when these things will happen, not even the angels in heaven or the Son himself. Only the Father knows.” [Matthew 24:36 NLT](#)

How does the Second Coming affect us?

³⁵ “Be dressed for service and keep your lamps burning, ³⁶ as though you were waiting for your master to return from the wedding feast. Then you will be ready to open the door and let him in the moment he arrives and knocks. ³⁷ The servants who are ready and waiting for his return will be rewarded. I tell you the truth, he himself will seat them, put on an apron, and serve them as they sit and eat! ³⁸ He may come in the middle of the night or just before dawn. We should be watching.

It will be good for those servants whose master finds them watching when he comes. Truly I tell you, he will dress himself to serve, will have them recline at the table and will come and wait on them.

We should be ready.
