## 1. Suffering Was Not God's Original Plan

# 2. God Understands Our Suffering

He was despised and rejected–a man of sorrows, acquainted with deepest grief. **Isaiah 53:3a (NLT)**

#### 3. God Uses Suffering for Good

And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose. **Romans 8:28 (NLT)**
