Personal Items

- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste, hair products, etc.)
- Towels and washcloths for showers
- Pool/Lake towel
- Twin-size sheets and comforter OR sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Refillable water bottle (PLEASE label with your name)

- Any required medications

Clothing

- Clothes for 5 days
- Athletic/workout clothes for games and activities
- Pajamas
- Swimsuits
 - Girls: One-piece swimsuit

- Flip-flops
